1. Presentation on National Reduction of Rural Local Roads Speed Limits

DOS Eamonn Hore gave a presentation on the new default 60km/hr speed limit for rural local roads confirming no road was deemed to warrant reinstating back to 80kmph.


The DOS and RSO took comments and questions from the Elected Members regarding the status and timeframe of the new signage currently being installed throughout the district, how it will affect the winter maintenance programme and how it was being funded.

The DOS confirmed the signage was being installed by a selection of contractors and WCC staff, that while there would be an impact on the Winter Maintenance programme, it needed to be completed. The RSO confirmed that while there was an allocation of €252 per pole and €59 per sign, there would be a shortfall in funding.
