Ferrybank Walkway, Wexford Town

Coordinates: 52°20'35.9"N 6°27'22.6"W



Trail Details

This trail is located directly off the R741 heading out of Wexford Town on the right-hand side with ample car-parking facilities, including designated parking for blue badge holders. It is a fully accessible looped walkway of less than 1km. The route takes you along the harbour's edge with working fishing vessels and pleasure craft moored. Seating and viewing points are dotted along the route which allow you to take full advantage of the views out to sea. Facilities include seating, sculptures, and a public swimming pool and leisure centre which has toilet facilities (including an accessible WC) and a Poolpod which assists people with limited mobility in safely accessing the swimming pool.



Parking & Approach

There is ample parking including designated blue badge parking spaces located directly within main entrance of Ferrybank car park. A charge of €2 applies for fully day parking. The route is firm and compact throughout of tarmacadam, widths of more than 2 meters - a multi user trail is firm. Car parking is also available at point 10 on the map - outside the Ferrybank Swimming Pool and Leisure Centre.



Facilities, Viewing Points & Seating

Viewing points and seating with back and armrests are located along this route, inviting visitors to take time out and enjoy the views across the harbour and out to sea.



Viewing Point

The trail has a wide multi-user walking route with magnificent ever-changing views out to sea.



Viewing Point

The trail offers the opportunity to branch off to the elevated viewing point located outside of the Swimming Pool and Leisure Centre. This offers the visitor the vantage point to take in the full extent of views across the Town (as an elevated site the approach in this area is sloped).
