Wexford Garda Youth Awards 2025

Guidelines

The award categories are for young people aged between 13 and 21 years of age.

There are 4 categories to select from.

- 1. **Individual Award** Making a positive contribution to their community, making it a better place to live.
- 2. **Group Award** Groups of 2 or more, making a positive contribution to their community, making it a better place to live.
- 3. **Special Achievement Award** Overcome difficult circumstances, defied all the odds, and whose commitment deserves recognition.
- 4. **Community Safety Award** Through a crime prevention or safety initiative / innovation, have made their community a safer place to live.

Each category will ask 5 questions in relation to the category selected.

Also please note the following:

- Awards are confined to those young people who are aged between 13 and 21 years on 31st January 2025.
- 6. Permanent residence of the young person must be in County Wexford.
- 7. Awards are confined to individuals and groups of two or more people.
- 8. Judge's decision is final.
- 9. The Judging Panel may decide upon one nominee in each category to go forward to represent the Division at the National Garda Youth Awards.
- 10. Any member of the public may nominate anyone whom they feel deserves an award.
- 11. Nominations may be submitted by family members or relatives.
- 12. Previous award winners are not eligible.
- 13. Forms must be signed by a nominator and co-nominator.
- 14. Please note that the Garda Youth Awards at Divisional and National level will receive media attention. Each award winner must sign a publication consent form. If consent is not given, you will still receive your award, but we will not be in a position to publicise you receiving the award at the award ceremony.

Applications must be submitted on or before 4.00pm Friday 28th March 2025.
