These sessions offer young people a chance to connect with the workshop leaders and find out more about the behind-the-scenes work involved in gaming and gamemaking. Vicky Twomey-Lee - Diversity in Tech Advocate Vicky is a techie based in Dublin. Since the first time Vicky set eyes on a Nintendo Famicom her dad brought back from Hong Kong in 1984, she has had her heart set on gaming as a career. With experience as a researcher and curator for the GAME exhibition at Science Gallery Dublin, Vicky is interested in game-making, creative technologies, traditional gaming crafts. She was the former Maker Advocate for Dublin Maker, and is the producer of The Irish Makers Podcast. Vicky runs game jams around Ireland through GameCraft which she co-founded with Michael Twomey.

Michael Twomey - Software Engineer Michael is an engineer based in Dublin. He helps bring people together through various groups, including Coding Grace and GameCraft. Through co-organising GameCraft game jams and workshops he teaches coding and electronic engineering. In his spare time he tinkers on various projects and devises new hardware for gaming controller workshops.
