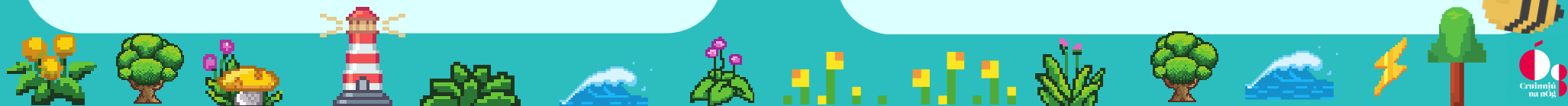

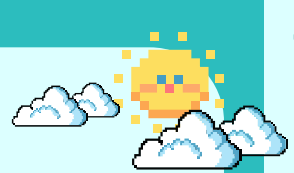
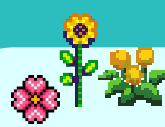
### Details:

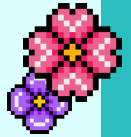

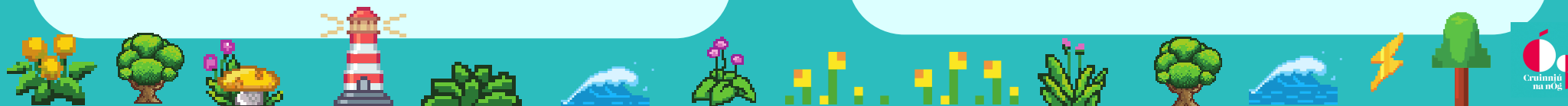
### Details:
