The Promenade Walkway, Enniscorthy

Trail Details

Located on the southside of Enniscorthy along the bank of the River Slaney, this accessible linear trail starts at the "new Bridge". There is an abundance of parking with designated parking for blue badge holders. The accessible walkway ends at the footbridge over the River Urrin. The trail to this point is fully accessible and level, with a number of seating and picnic benches. Take the time to stop for a break and view the river and all its flora, birds and wildlife.



Parking & Approach

Parking including accessible designated blue badge parking is available both at the trail head and beside the playground, which is located midway along the route. The multi-user linear trail has a tarmacadam surface and widths of more than 2 meters, with public lighting along the route to support ease of access for visitors both day and night.



Playground & Facilities

The playground located along this walking trail promotes inclusive play opportunities for all ages and abilities and offers visitors with children another amenity to enjoy along this route.



Facilities

A hotel located mid-way along this route offers the opportunity for visitors to avail of refreshments. Picnic benches and seating along the length of the riverbank allow for the visitor to rest, take time out and enjoy nature at its best with the banks of the River Slaney supporting a variety of bird wildlife.
